Phonics

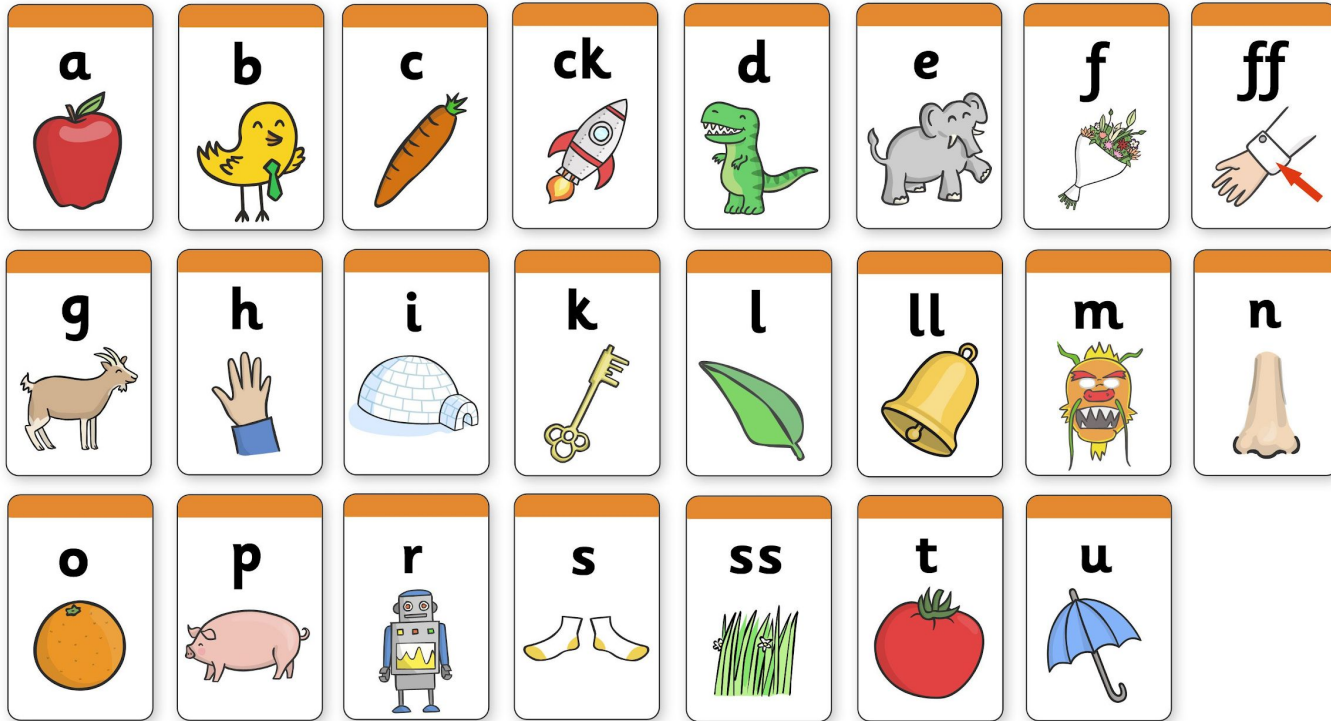
Please recap the Phase 2 sounds with your child (see next slide).

Then say the following words to your child and let them have a go at sounding out and writing the following words (without them looking at them - they may need a sound mat to do this - see next slide):

bat, duck, red, ball, fish

Then practice writing Phase 2 tricky words:

the, no, I, go, into



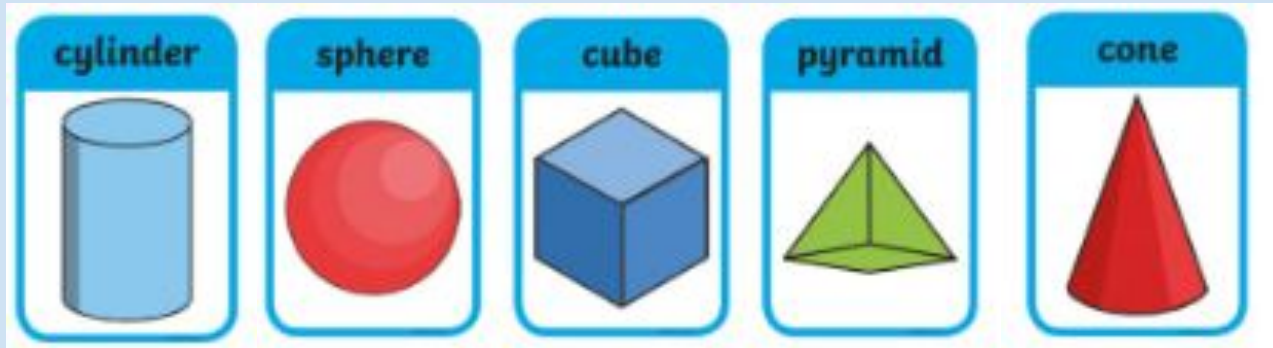
My Phase 2 sound mat

Maths - 3D Shape

Look at the pictures of the shapes and discuss some of the names.

Discuss what they notice about the shapes e.g. the cube looks similar to a square.

Look around the house and garden for any of these shapes.

Duck, duck, goose

Bean game (your child can teach you this - chilli bean, broad bean, baked bean, runner bean, jelly bean)
