

English Spring counting story





You should already have a sentence for Monday and Tuesday, now it's time to write a sentence for Wednesday.

Remember because it is a counting story the numbers go up, so today you will see 3 ...

When there is more than one noun this is called a plural. You need to add the suffix -s or -es to the noun.

On the next slide my example for Wednesday.

Remember the adjective goes before the noun.

I challenged myself to write the word. You could also write the numeral.

On Wednesday, I went on a spring walk and I saw three fluffy ducklings swimming in the pond.

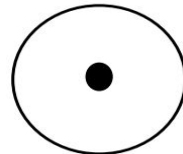
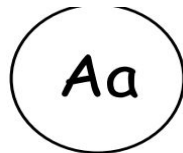
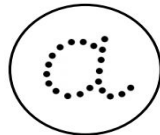
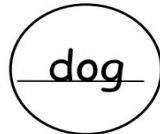
I chose a duckling as my noun and because there are 3 it has the suffix -s

I chose the verb swim. The ducklings are doing it now so we add the suffix -ing to become swimming.

I wrote some more detail to say where the ducklings were swimming.

Things to remember:

- Capital letter
- Spelling of the day of the week
- The number
- Noun with the suffix -s or -es
- Adjective
- Verb ending with -ing
