Phonics

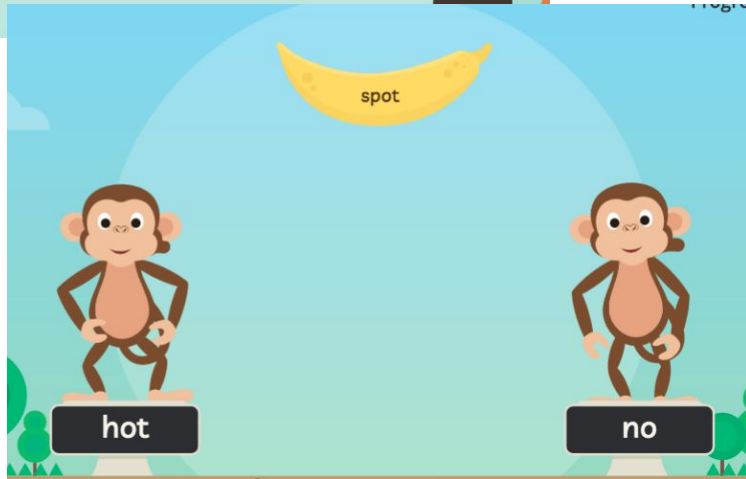




Phonics Play is currently free to access and has a brand new, fresh website. The children can explore these games independently.
