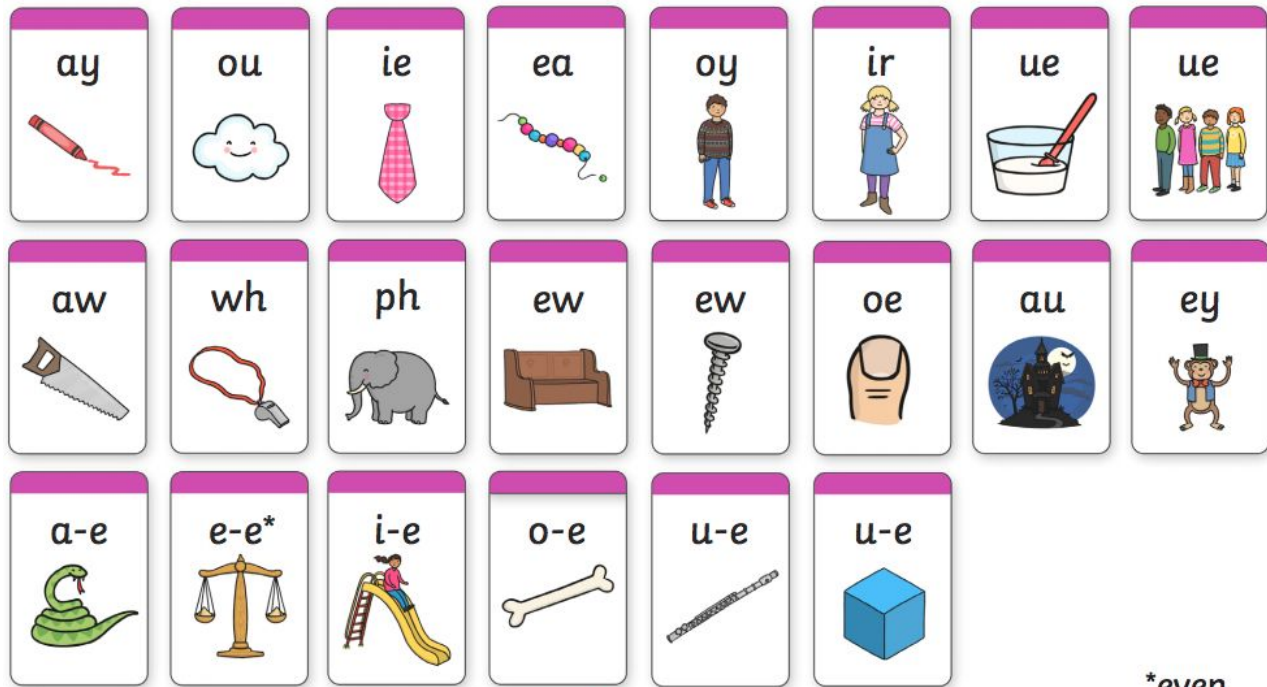

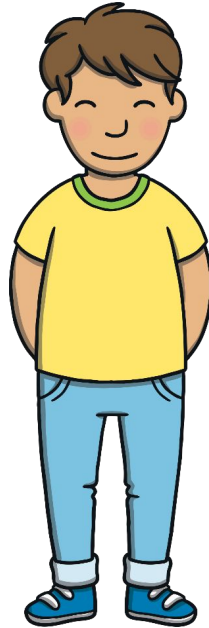




Yesterday, we learnt the diagraph **ow** that makes the 'oa' sound.

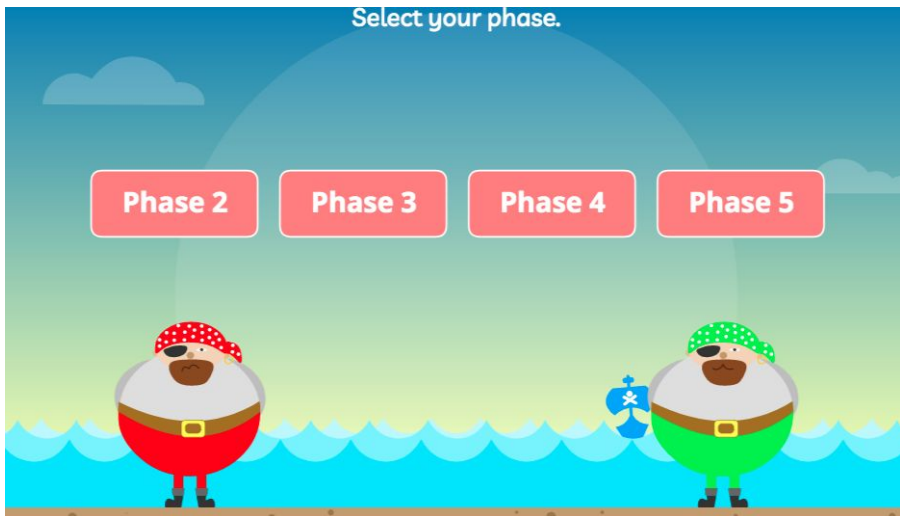
