Remember vowels can either make the letter sound or the letter name.

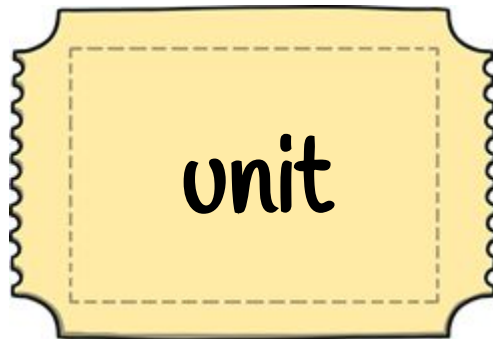


Remember, with a southern accent this can sound like /u/ or short /oo/ for the **short** vowel sound e.g. but and put
and /yoo/ and long /oo/ for the **long** vowel sound e.g. unit and fruit

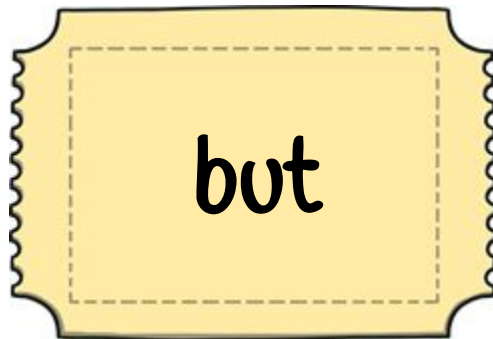
