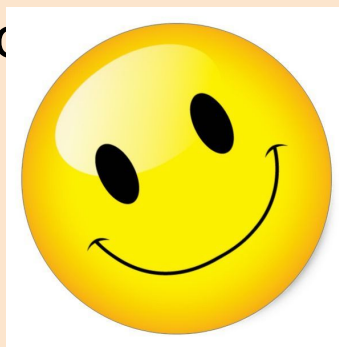

We look forward to seeing them



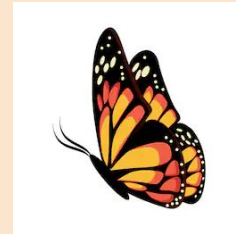
