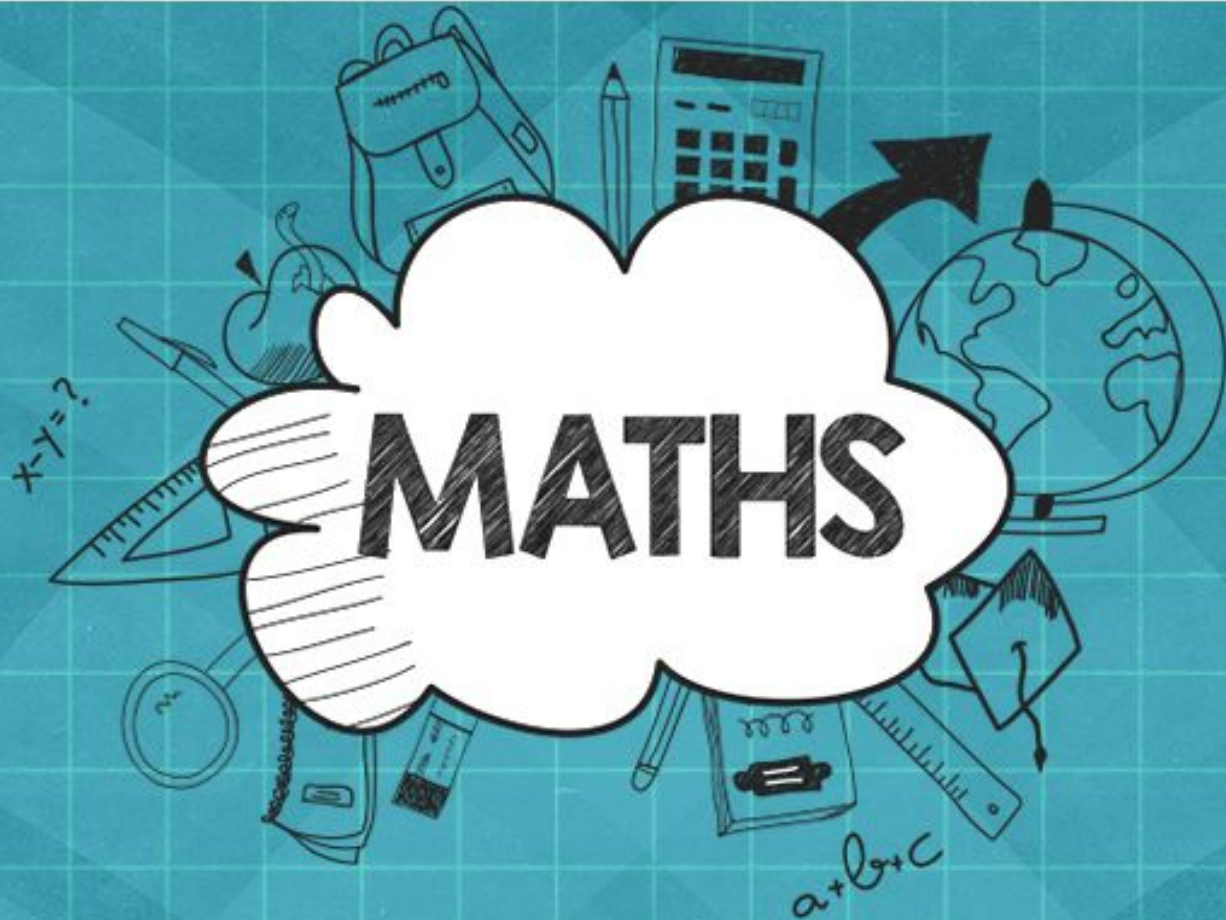

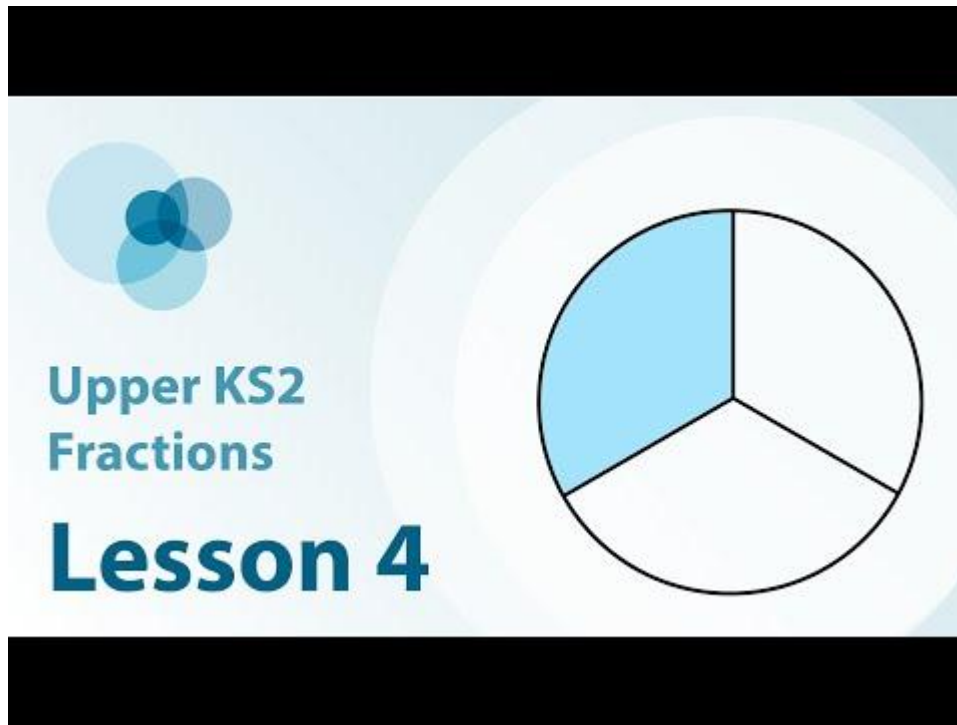

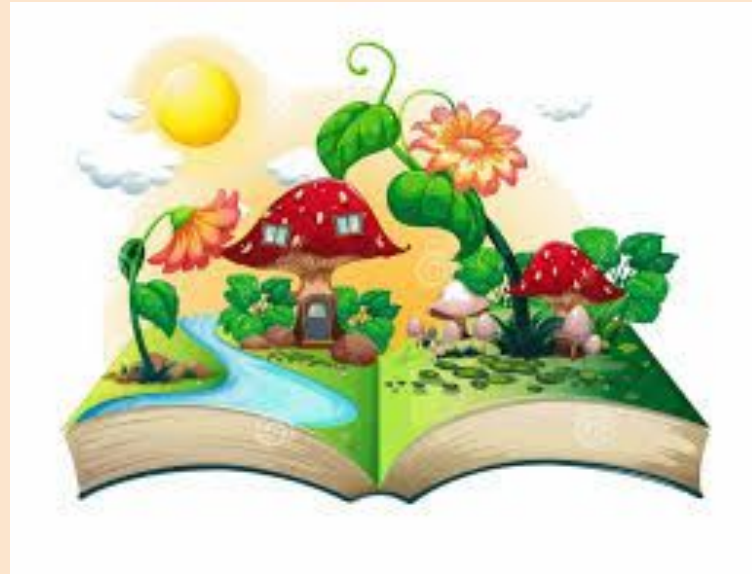
Do you remember the features of a fairy tale?

Common Elements of a FAIRY TALE

- A fairy tale has a theme or teaches an important lesson.
- Fairy tales may include magic, fantasy, or make-believe elements.
- There is a problem or conflict in the story and a happy ending when it is resolved.
- Fairy tales are set in the past and often begin with "Once upon a time."
- Fairy tales often include events, people, or objects in sets of three.
- The setting is often enchanted and may include royalty.
- Animals can sometimes talk or have other special abilities.
- A fairy tale includes good and evil characters.


Today we are going to plan our own fairy tale story.



Example

I am going to start by writing down some thoughts about the characters, setting and plot.

Characters	Setting	Plot
<p>Sunny Gold- golden long hair, lives in the forest with her family. Best friends with Mr Apple her horse. Green Witch- evil witch with bright green hair.</p>	<p>The Royal Manor Forest- thick, dense, lush green woodland that surrounds the Kingdom of Kingsold. Green Witch's lair- damp, dark cave far east in the forest. Surrounded by nettles and thick branches. No animals live there.</p>	<p>Mr Apple is turned into a dragon by Green Witch, who was being chased by the royal guards because she stole the Star Diamond from the castle, so she can escape home. Sunny Gold joins with guards to retrieve Mr Apple.</p>



I have remembered to include features of a fairy tale. E.g. magic, talking animals, forest setting.

Example: boxing up

Next I will carefully box up the key plot points ready for tomorrow.

Beginning	Sunny Gold, tending to her best friend, talking horse Mr Apple with deep rich chestnut coat. Talking about their plans for future adventure to Little Wood in the Regal land the other side of the castle.
Build up	Sunny Gold hears high pitched screaming and smoke coming from the forest. A cackle is heard and Green Witch appears, putting a spell on Mr Apple and turning him into a dragon to fly off with. Royal guards appear and explain situation.
Problem	Along with the guards, Sunny Gold ventures into the forest to the east side where Green Witch lives, sees pixies and dwarves who lead the way. Approach cave where Green Witch lives, hears cackles and sees Mr Apple chained up. Sunny Gold runs in and confronts the witch.
Resolution	Witch is just about to put a spell on Sunny but Sunny explains why she was wrong to steal her horse and the diamond. People will treat you how you treat them and always live in fear of you. Green Witch apologetic and agrees to return to castle for punishment.
Ending	Green Witch turns Mr Apple back to a horse and gives up her magic, she goes to castle with guards. Sunny Gold and Mr Apple return home before new adventure.

Yes you can!

You can be creative with who your characters are- if you want your 'hero' to be a wolf and the 'villian' to be a pig that is fine!

Help!

If you are really stuck and can't think of a plot, then use a story you know e.g. The Three Little Pigs and change the characters and setting to suit your story.

Task: Plan your fairy tale.

Using google docs, write down your key characters, setting and plot. Then box up your story in preparation for tomorrow!

Make sure you include key features of a fairy tale e.g. talking animals, magic, far away kingdom.

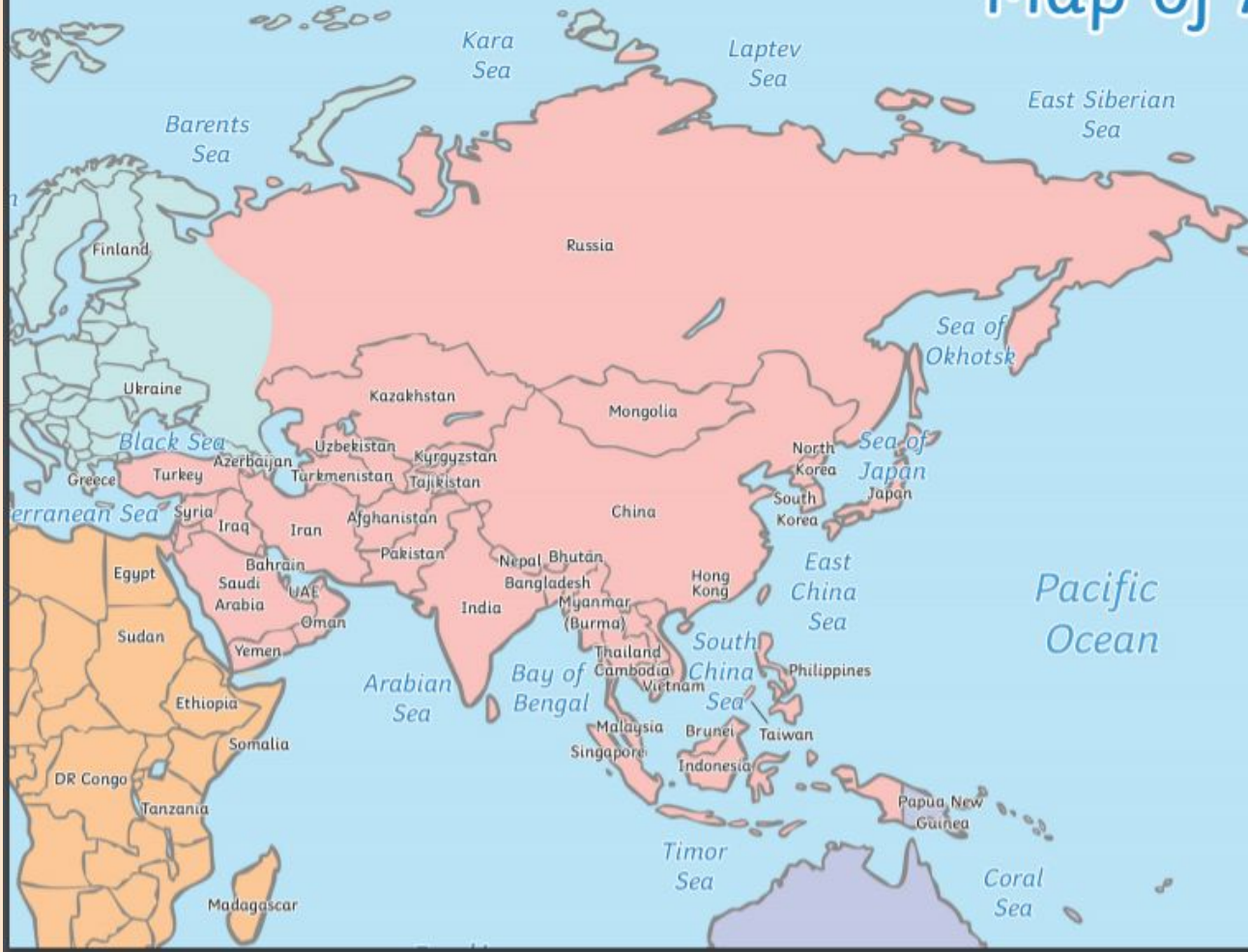

Task 1: Label the countries in Asia on the map.

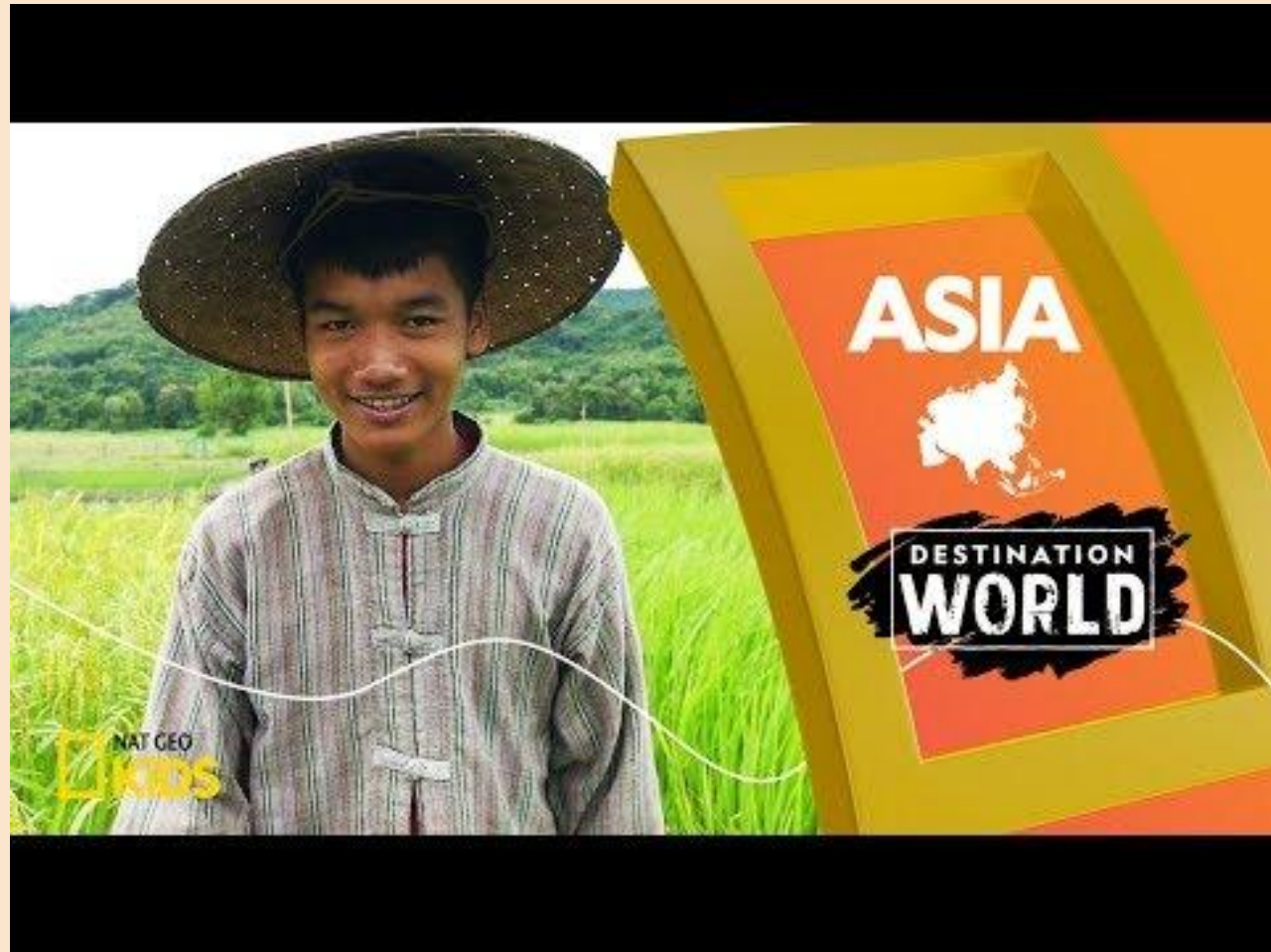
Using the previous slide, label Asian countries and oceans on the map.



What is a human feature?

They are features on Earth because of human intervention. Examples of human features of the world include things such as language, religion, political systems, economic systems, cities, population and buildings.



What is a physical feature?

Physical features are naturally-created features of the earth. These would include: land, rivers, mountains, volcanoes, hills, coasts, islands and waterfalls, to name a few.




Task 2: On your map, label five physical and human features of Asia. You will have to do some research to do this task.
