Maths

Comparing mass

Teaching points notes and guidance.

Children continue to use non-standard units to weigh objects and now focus on comparing the mass of two objects. They use balance scales to compare two objects and use the language of 'heavier', 'lighter' and 'equal to'. Once children are confident using this language they can use $<$, $>$ and $=$ to compare mass.

Weight

When we talk about weight, we mean how heavy or light something is.
Sometimes we call this mass.

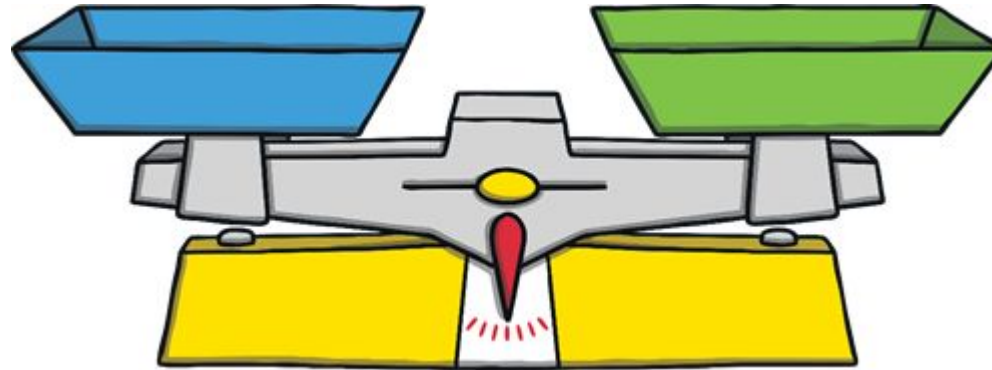

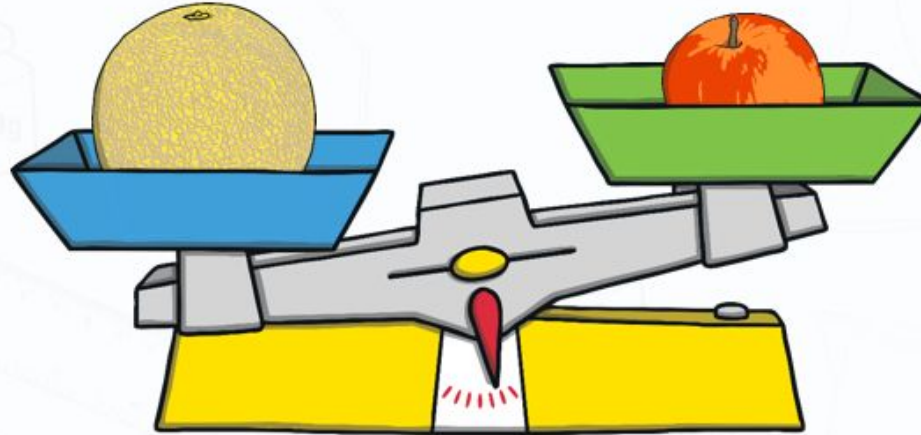
We know the puppy and the kitten weigh the same because the scales are equally balanced.

The melon is bigger than the apple.

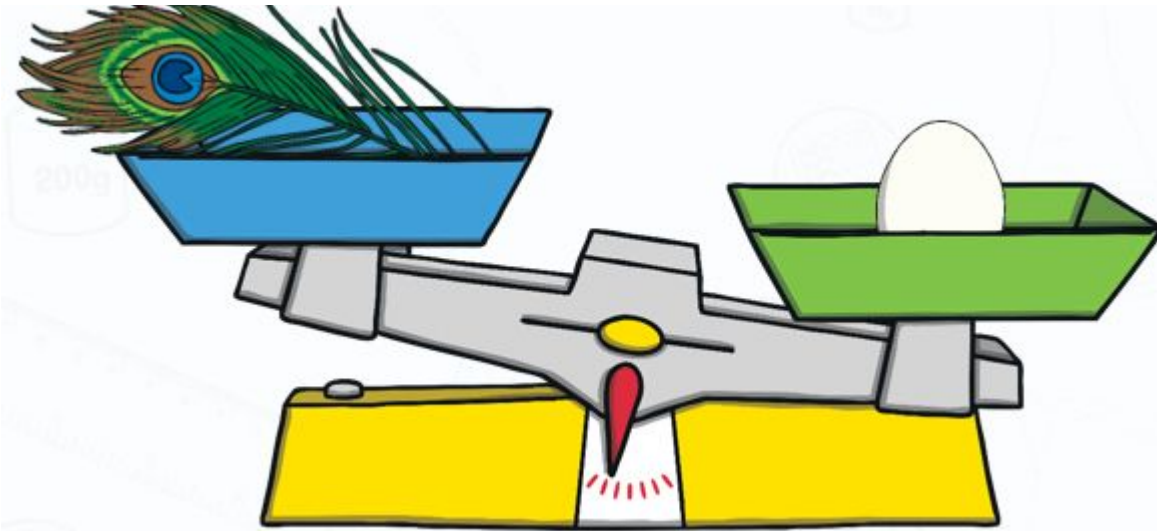
The melon is heavier than the apple.

The feather is bigger than the egg.

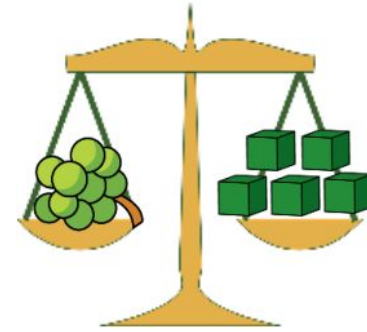
The egg is heavier than the feather.



The scale shows us that the egg is heavier even though the egg is smaller.

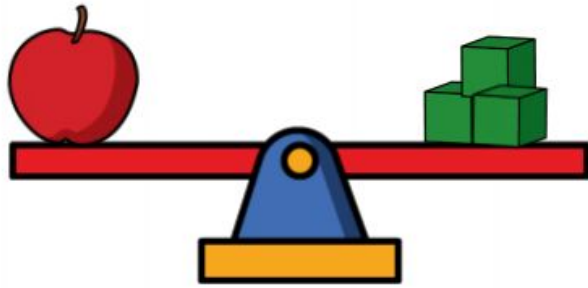
