What is a book review?



A book review is written about a book that you have read.

Book reviews share opinions of a book.

Book reviews say what you like or didn't like.


Book reviews help to show others what the book is about so that they can decide if they want to read it.


Today, we would like you to think about your favourite part of the book you chose.

Was it easy to choose a favourite part?

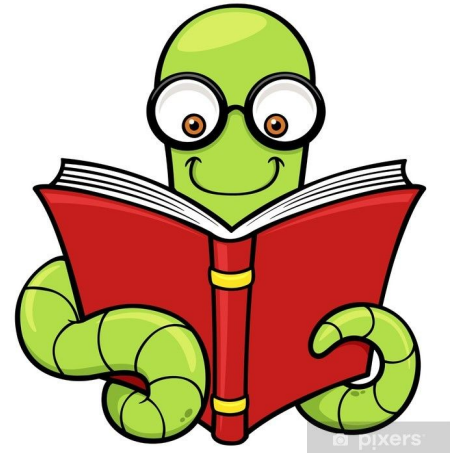
When you have decided on your favourite part, we would like you to draw a picture of it.

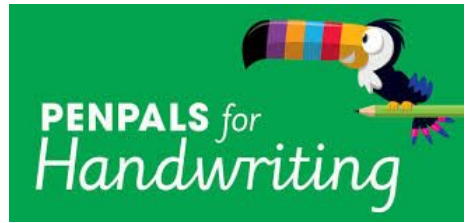

Handwriting

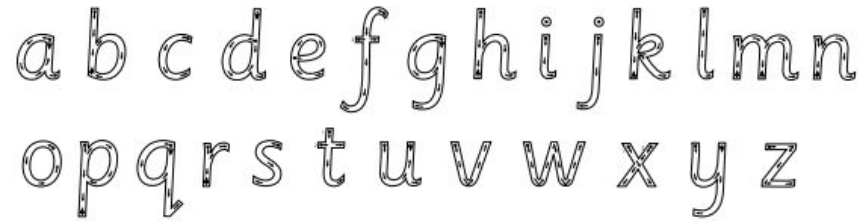


Many of you have asked about how to support with handwriting at home.
