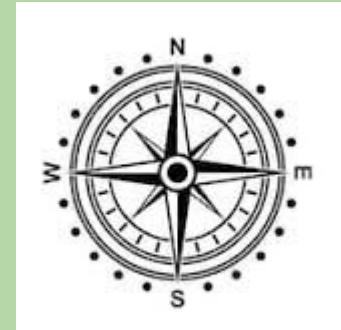

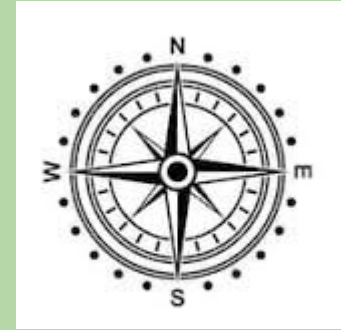
London landmarks



1. Compare the tea towel above with a paper map or online map.
2. Use your geographical knowledge of directions (North, South, East, West) to identify the errors.

Clue- think where the landmarks are in relation to the River Thames.

1. Write a set of instructions to get from Westminster Abbey to The Gherkin.
2. Think about the language you will need to use (over, past, North, South, East, West, time vocabulary: first, next...)
3. Think about the best way to set out instructions (bullet points, lists, short sentences)
