How to make delicious crunchy mars bar cakes

Ingredients

2 medium sized mars bar

50g Rice Krispies

25g Butter

You will need :

A large pan A tray or dish

Knife and board

Mixing spoon

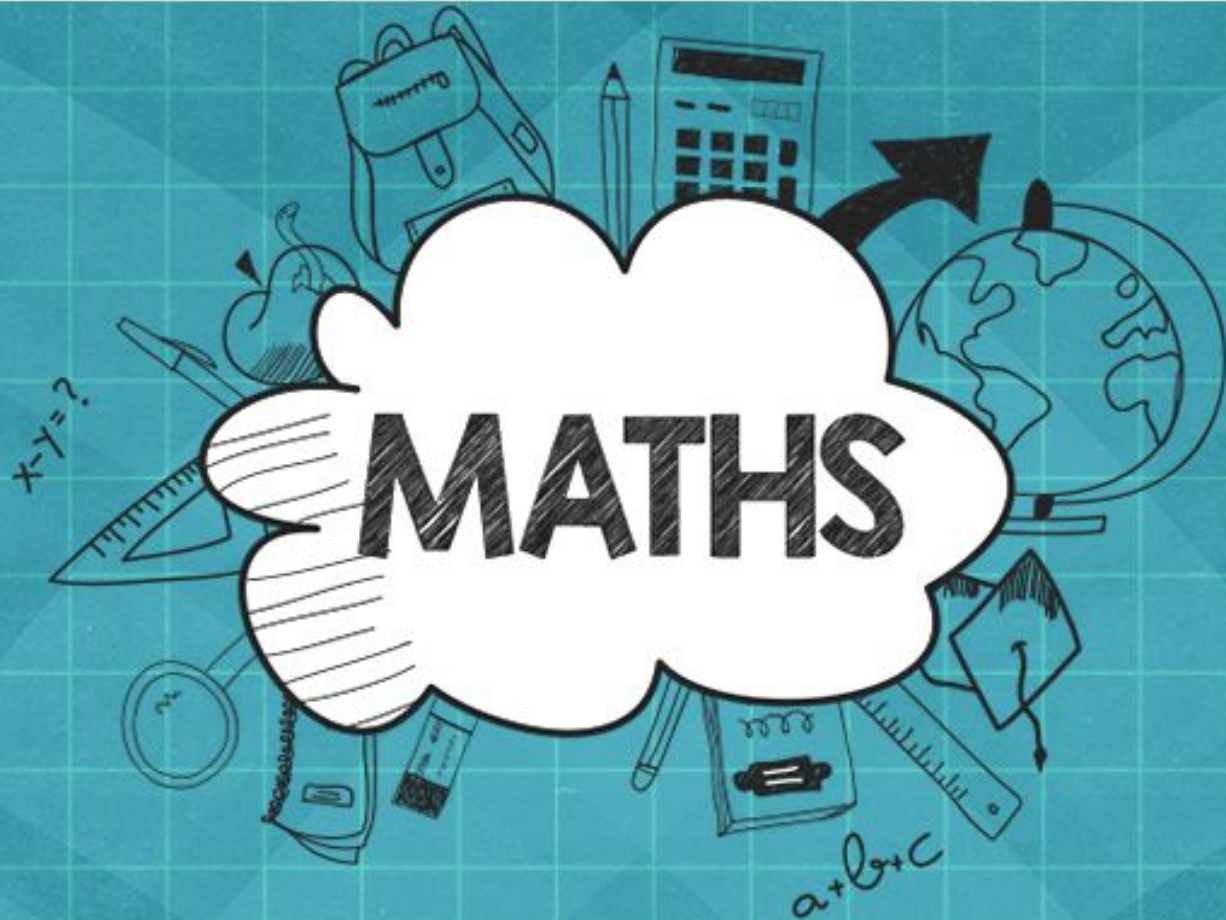

1. Grease your dish or tray to stop your yummy mars bar cakes from sticking to the sides (later).
2. Using your knife carefully cut the mar bar into small pieces and place them in a big pan.
3. Weigh out your butter.
4. Using your knife carefully cut the butter into small pieces and add them to the big pan.
5. Turn the heat onto about medium.
6. Gently stir the mixture until the butter and mars bars melt. 7. Your mixture may go a bit lumpy, but just keep stirring until the mixture is smooth.
8. When the mixture is smooth, turn off the heat.
9. Remove the pan from the cooker.
10. Add the rice krispies to the big pan.
11. Stir in the rice krispies until they are all coated in mars bar mix.
12. Put the mixture into the greased dish.
13. Put into the fridge and leave until set.
14. Cut into squares or rectangles and enjoy you delicious cooking.

# So, to write a good set of instructions, you need these key features:

- Heading (stating what the instructions are for)
- Subheadings (ingredients or equipment, and method)
- Numbered steps
- Time conjunctions for each step (then, next, after)
- Imperative verbs (bossy verbs, such a cut, wipe, saw)
- Ensure **all** steps are included
- Optional: pictures - useful to see what is being made and/or for each step
