Rhyming couplet poems have 2 lines that rhyme (1st and 2nd lines rhyme, then 3rd and 4th lines rhyme, and so on).

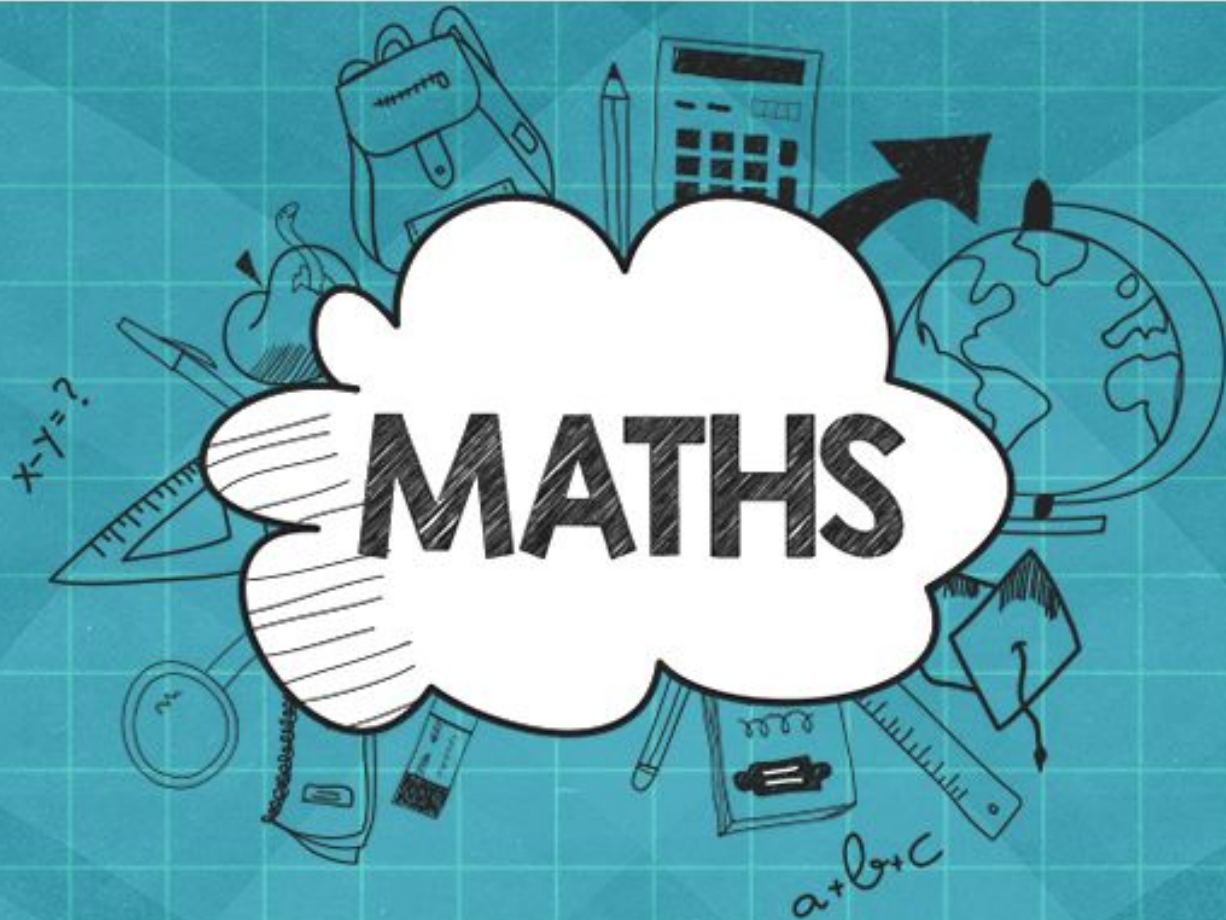
You are going to create your own poem with

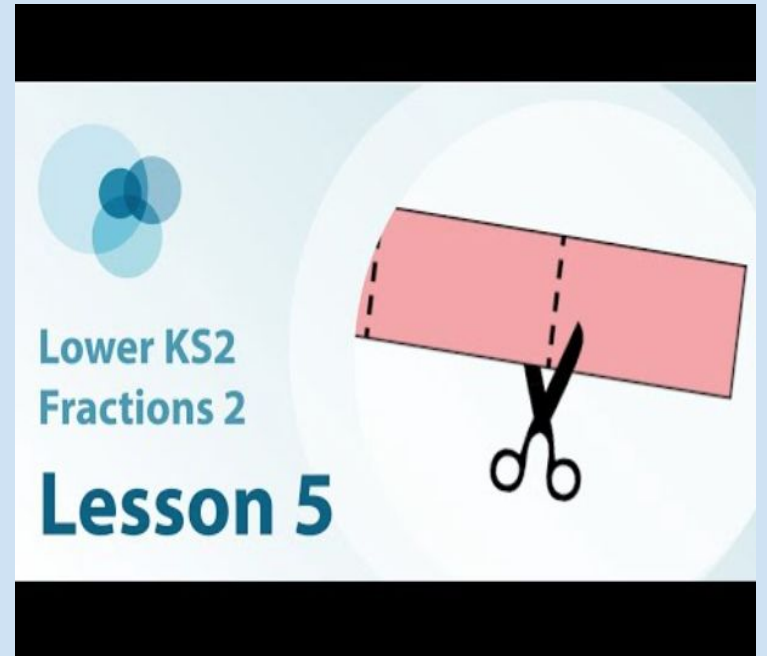
