Using the plan from yesterday, you will be writing your own persuasive letter.

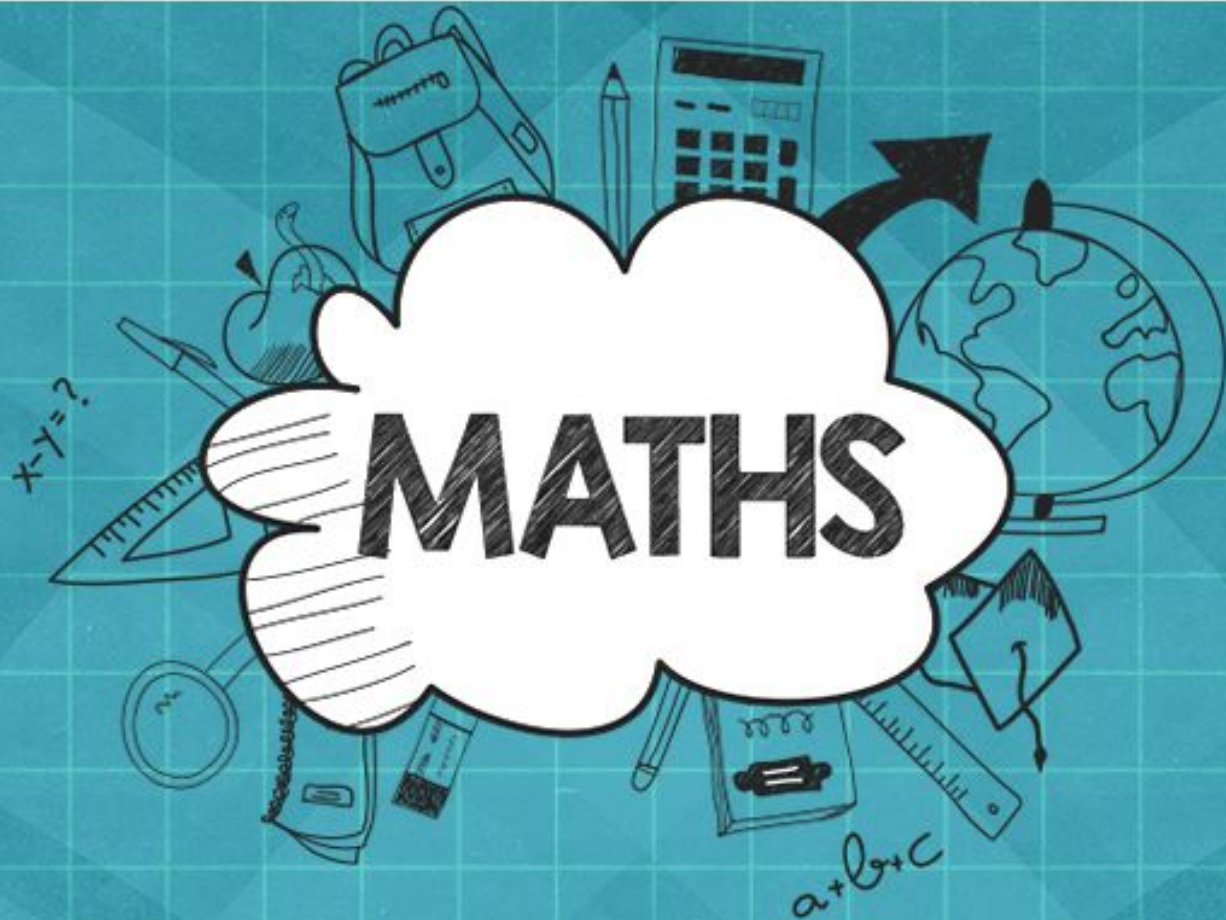
On the next slide, you will see an example of my plan (key words only) and the write up into full sentences.



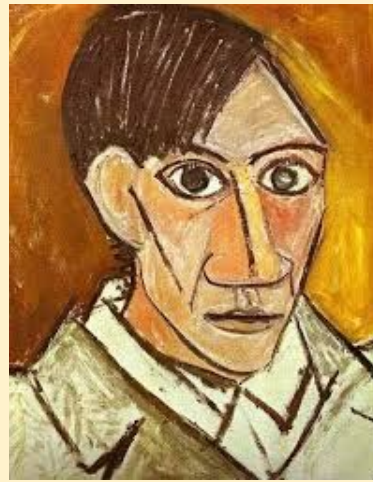
Pablo Picasso
