

Roman Baths Floor Plan

I can explain what Roman baths were and know about the different amenities they contained.

Imagine you are a rich Roman who has just opened a new bathhouse. Use the information that you have learnt in the lesson and the notes you made earlier and do some of your own research using books and the Internet to help you plan, design and produce a floor plan to show what is inside the bathhouse. You should label each room so that visitors can figure out where everything is!

When you have drawn the plan, you should choose three of the rooms and write instructions on how to use that room, e.g. how to use changing rooms, how to use the caldarium, etc. The picture below shows an example of a floor plan of a Roman bathhouse to give you some ideas.
