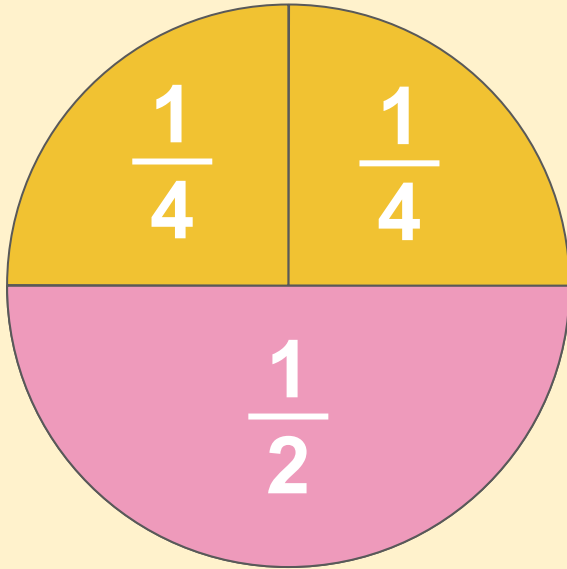
Maths
